

## **Combined BS in Mathematics-MS in Statistics Application Form 2008**

### **Admission Criteria**

Undergraduate Mathematics majors with a minimum GPA of 3.0 in mathematics at the end of their junior year are eligible to apply for the combined BS-MS program. A letter of recommendation from one of their statistics professors is required. Students should have taken at least one 400 level statistics course at Montclair State University. The Graduate Record Examination (GRE) is not required. A committee that includes the department chair, the statistics committee chair, and the graduate coordinator will review applications at the department level. Applications recommended by this committee will be reviewed by the Graduate School for final approval. Students enrolled in the program are expected to meet all standards established by the graduate school. Students who have completed a B.S. in Mathematics are not eligible for this program.
