Criteria for Qualification:

- First-time, full-time graduate student in a master's program in the College of Science and Mathematics (CSAM), or the School of Business (SBUS)
- Meet all MSU Graduate Admissions criteria
- Intend on pursuing a career in the Pharmaceutical industry
- Prior relevant work experience, internship or research, etc. with supporting letter(s) of recommendation a plus
- Not receiving any other scholarship/ assistantship from Montclair State University

Application Process:

The following need to be submitted to:

- A concise statement (not to exceed 2 pages) of interest in a career in the pharmaceutical, medical devices, biotechnology or related industry
- Two letters of recommendation from individuals who can speak to your credentials and goals

Award:

Tuition scholarship of \$3,000 per year for 2 years

Renewal:

(For second year award renewal)

- Must maintain a minimum of 3.0 overall GPA
- No grade(s) lower than a B
- Maintained fulltime status in prior semesters
- Demonstrate continued pursuit of pharma career goals
- Progress report on first year research and other activities
- Participated in pharma-related activities
